## **Philip Harris, Ph.D.** **WW-2 Navy Radarman**

It is with great sadness that I write to you today about the loss of Philip Harris, Ph.D., He served U.S. Navy 1944-1946. A close friend, a fellow Navy Leaguer, and Navy Radarman from World War II. He leaves behind his lovely wife Carol. It was only a few years ago that Phil discovered the Navy League. After our brief chat he said sign me up. He was a loyal supporter of our Youth Programs and to our Council. Phil and Carol represented the Palm Beach Council for Station XO Zack Hornby Commissioned as Chief Warrant Officer January 23, 2015 at U.S. Coast Guard Station Lake Worth Inlet. His appreciation for the Youth Appreciation Awards Dinner was tremendous. His 91 years were spectacular. He and his wife entertained Gilbert and Sullivan's operettas on Cruise Ships. He loved birds, butterflies, classical music and astronomy but more important is his wife Carol. She was his prize of all time. He was a Professor at Baruch College of C.U.N.Y. His work as an Arbitrator spanned 53 years. He worked on D.O.D. and D.O.J. cases and was presented with Award of Distinction plaque from the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service Washington, D.C. upon his retirement. Phil called me in December and January to be certain he would be at the installation of the first female President for Palm Beach Council.
